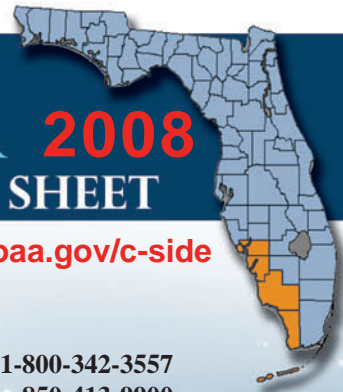

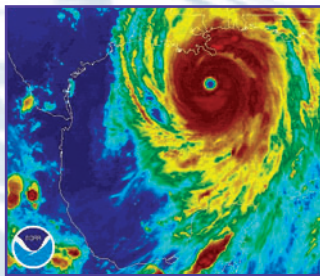

**NOAA Satellites and Information Service (National Environmental Satellite, Data and Information Service) - NESDIS** operates the satellites and manages the processing and distribution of millions of bits of data and images these satellites produce daily. The prime customer for the satellite data is the NOAA National Weather Service, which uses satellite data to create forecasts for television, radio, and weather advisory services.

NOAA Weather Radio (NWR) All Hazards is a nationwide network of radio stations broadcasting continuous weather information directly from a nearby National Weather Service office. NWR broadcasts National Weather Service warnings, watches, forecasts, and other hazard information 24 hours a day.

## A Personalized Travel Information Service

My Florida 511 is a free service of the Florida Department of Transportation. Travelers can dial 511 to access current information for specific routes and roadway segments, including:

- anticipated travel delays
- traffic accidents
- roadway blockages and lane closures.

When callers dial 511, the service automatically connects to the most local 511 service available from the current location. However, you can transfer to other Florida area 511 services from any Florida location.

Through Florida 511, callers will be able to receive information on all interstate roads across the state, including:

I-4, I-10, I-75, I-95, I-110, I-175, I-195, I-275, I-295, I-375, I-395, I-595, and Florida's Turnpike.

Callers can also transfer to a local 511 service for more detailed information and more road choices.

The My Florida 511 Website incorporates motion images from traffic cameras, e-mail alerts, public transportation information and customer feedback.
