

214 Communications

The Communications Mission of CAP is to organize and maintain a reliable nationwide point-to-point, air-to-ground and ground mobile capability for use in search and rescue, civil defense, and disaster relief missions and to augment other existing communications services in the event of floods, fire, tornado and similar natural disasters and to support the US Air Force Survival and Recovery program. Squadron level Communications is responsible for managing and directing communications activities in accordance with National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) which is responsible for regulation and coordination of telecommunications among federal agencies. The FCC is not responsible for federal agencies. Communications will train squadron members to operate CAP radios and radio stations. They will assist members to receive the required ROA certification.
